Tell us about your role?

As Research Delivery Officer for the West Yorkshire and Harrogate Clinical Commissioning Groups (CCGs) I promote and support research within primary care. This includes supporting members of study teams by providing advice on recruitment sites; building trust, confidence and goodwill with both the CCGs and general practices across West Yorkshire and Harrogate to encourage wider participation in research activities; ensuring research is taking place safely and efficiently; and increasing awareness of research taking place within the area.

How did you come to work in R&D?

I have worked for the NHS since 2012 in a variety of roles: supporting the Leeds Primary Care Mental Health team, Prison Healthcare for HMP Leeds and the Research and Development department of Leeds and York Partnership NHS Foundation Trust, which is where I became involved in health research as a Research Assistant – managing and delivering health research projects in the community.
